Program Description

- Part-time online program July through August
- Graduates receive special advantages to start a government career

Scholarship

- All participants receive a full-tuition scholarship and a monthly living stipend
- Award funded by the National Security Education Program, which is administered by the Defense Language and National Security Education Office
- Limited financial support available for relocation to the Washington, DC, area

To be eligible, you must:

- Be a U.S. citizen
- Be a native speaker of one of the critical languages; past critical languages have included Amharic, Arabic, Azerbaijani, Balochi, Bambara, Chinese Mandarin, Hausa, Hindi, Kazakh, Kirghiz, Kurdish, Korean, Persian Dari, Persian Farsi, Punjabi, Pushto/ Pashto, Russian, Somali, Tadjik, Tamashek, Thai, Tigrinya, Turkish, Ukrainian, Urdu, Uzbek and Vietnamese.
- Have advanced proficiency in English
- Have a college degree (B.A./B.S. or equivalent)
- Be able to commit to a full-time day program from January through June at Georgetown University School of Continuing Studies
- Agree to work for the federal government—in a position with national security responsibilities for at least one year
